Potential Available Funding

Discretionary Crisis Fund (DCF):

DCF is a final safety net if you are experiencing a crisis and cannot resolve your financial difficulties any other way. DCF provides essential items for people in urgent need. It does not provide cash.

Department for Work & Pensions (DWP):

Budgeting Advance – If you are already receiving Universal Credit, or other eligible benefits, you may be able to get a Budgeting Advance to help pay for emergency household costs, for example, buying a new cooker or for help getting a job or staying in work. Apply by contacting your job center plus work coach.

Family Action's Welfare Grants Programme:

Family Action's Welfare Grants programme aims to help prevent an immediate crisis from spiraling and threatening the stability of families and individuals.



All applications must be made, on-line, by a

suitable referring agency. Suitable referring agencies include statutory agencies or charities that provide health or social care; housing associations; probation services and GP's.

Homeless Prevention Fund (HPF):

The Homeless Prevention Fund (HPF) is a pot of money that can be used to prevent a customer from becoming homeless or support a customer who is already experiencing homelessness. The funds can be used to cover a range of different situations, but the Officer will have to demonstrate that the funds will effectively resolve a customer's Homelessness.

Talisman Charitable Trust:

Assists individuals in the UK of small means who the trustees consider to be deserving and may be described as "going short".

In general, the relief of poverty includes grants for education, health, housing disablement or disability.

Applications should be made on behalf of individuals by a local authority, another charitable organisation, or a non-profit organisation such as the Citizens' Advice Bureau.
